National Alliance for the Development of Archery (NADA) Basic Instructor Certification at Camp High Point June 1, 2009 \$30

Learn how to set up and operate a safe short-term archery program, how to teach new archers, how to maintain your equipment, and how to create fun games for your new archers. Certification is valid for 3 years. This is the Basic course – the Intermediate course is required to train others to become instructors.

Recommended for: Camp Directors, Program Directors, Counselors, and Archery Program Instructors.

Certification: Participants must pass a written test and demonstrate competency in the required skills.

Successful candidates will receive NADA Basic Instructor certification, which allows them to teach archery skills to others. This is *not* the instructor/trainer (Intermediate) certification that allows you to *certify* others as instructors.

Cost: \$30.00 includes manual, materials, testing, certification card, and lunch.
